

## Infection Control Policy

In order to reduce the spread of illness in the nursery, following regulations apply:

Please DO NOT send your child to nursery if:

- The child has a skin rash that has not been assessed by a doctor.
- The child is vomiting or suffering from diarrhea.
- The child has heavy green nasal discharge.
- The child is suffering from sore throat or persistent cough.
- The child has red, watery and painful eyes.
- The child is suffering from any other contagious disease.
- Head Lice.
- The child is having fever.

Note: if your child has fever the night before or in the morning and has received medication like panadol / Adol and the fever subsides (because of the medication), he/she still carries the infection and will spread it to others in the nursery. Hence, he/she is still not fit to attend nursery.

We urge you to respect this policy for the sake of your own child and all the other children in the nursery.

If at the nursery gate, we find your child to be a possible source of infection to other children, you will be politely asked to take the child back.
